

President's Report

Dear Members.

The COVID impact changed significantly at the beginning of December and I hope we can remain on this path until an effective vaccine is distributed. The Resorts, our Lodge management teams and members did a tremendous job sticking to the plan and with an element of luck we got through winter without a known COVID case in the mountains.

I feel for members who have been seriously affected by the COVID pandemic and hope the easing of restrictions and an effective vaccine will provide a prompt recovery.

I was disappointed to hear Perisher Blue and NPWS have withdrawn from head lease negotiations, for a long time this has been seen as the way forward for Perisher's vitality and summer operation.

On the up side the Snowy Mountains Special Activation Precinct has been formed to identify and support a range of initiatives to activate the local towns and Resorts to ensure the area will be resilient and well placed for growth.

At the end of the first year with Clubman I am pleased with the outcome. A lot of work was required from the Club's Secretaries, Duncan and Leanne, Treasurer, David Collett and the Lodge Booking Officers who all needed to adapt to the new system. I am very grateful for their assistance through the changeover.

Program developer David Banham from Notbad Software provided tremendous support and has implemented many improvements to suit our use. I also want to thank you, the members, for accepting the new platform and trusting the linked Stripe payment gateway. It is certainly much more efficient having payments receipted by Clubman without requiring committee intervention.

Clubman certainly proved its worth when so many COVID booking refunds were required. I remind you that when refunds occur the funds go back to the card that was used for the payment.

There was a lot of uncertainty and unfortunately many member's winter bookings needed to be cancelled to comply with social distancing rules. I thank the Lodge Booking officers who were working with members to find alternative accommodation dates and thank you, the members, for your

understanding and patience.

I know your patience was further tested by ticket sales at the Resorts and I hope there will be improvement if mountain numbers are restricted next season.

During the past year the Committee approved 89 new memberships. Many of these were families who, with the new single members, added a total of 381 individuals to our member list. The 75 member's children who reached 19 years of age prior to 30 Sept 2019 were rolled over to single adult membership however only 33 of them remain financial.

This year we commenced a new initiative to contact the 91 members who turned 19 during the past year to offer them individual adult membership. 60 took up the offer and their email addresses and phone numbers were added to Clubman before their member number was allocated. We hope this improves connection with these members.

The Club's financial position remains sound. The increase in subscriptions and joining fees has lifted our income at the same time COVID reduced the planned expenditure so we have a surplus that will allow us to pay 2021 sponsorships and other expenses without the usual contribution from the Lodge Cooperative.

Club has sponsored Sami Kennedy-Sim for the 2020-21 northern winter. We wish Sami all the best in her endeavours. See Snippets on page 5.

I really appreciate efforts of the 2020 Committee and thank them for their contributions.

I particularly want to acknowledge the work of retiring committee members, Vice President, Kim Easdale, Vice-Captain, Tim Easdale and Auditor, Ron Giles.

We had a good attendance at Norths for the AGM. We had a glitch with the online link that we were unable to overcome on the night. I apologise to those who could not login to the meeting however the meeting was recorded. If anyone wants to view please contact me

The Committee nominations matched the positions so an election for 2021 Committee was not required. I welcome the new Committee members, vice-president Oliver Small, vice-captain, Daniel Kavo and auditor, Dynasty Colelough.

I thank outgoing Juniors Chair, Stuart Jones, and Juniors secretary Lisa Manoy for their contributions to the Junior committee and look forward to working with new Chair, Darren Gore, and his vice-chair, Sandra Brinkman. After the lack of activity in 2020 the Juniors are looking for a secretary, if you would like to help please contact Darren.

In 2021 I hope we can run Club events under less stringent COVID rules, consolidate the use of Clubman and continue the work on Club policy documents and the social media team will be looking to add Instagram beside our Facebook presence.

Our next Club Committee meeting is online on 17 February at 8pm. Members are welcome to login and have their say.

Congratulations to Kim Easdale who was awarded life membership at the AGM after many years of involvement with Club events. Since 2001 Kim has been part of the Juniors program, our Snow Australia delegate, helps the Perisher Cup Committee and the SASC team, Club Secretary/Acting Secretary 2017 – 2019. Kim also picked up organisation of Race Week trophies and has been a Lodge Coop director since 2019.

Life memberships are not awarded very often so I was honoured to also be recognised. My contribution commenced when elected Juniors Chairman in 2002 and has only been possible with members backing and the trust of Club Committees, Lodge Coop Directors and Officers. I enjoy the challenges and find volunteering very satisfying. I thank my family for their assistance and allowing my time to be shared with Southern Alps.

I look forward to improving conditions in 2021.
